

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
CAMP BLANDING JOINT TRAINING CENTER
AND
CAMP BLANDING ROD & GUN CLUB, INCORPORATED**

1. This Agreement is entered into and agreed upon this 1st day of June 2009, between Camp Blanding Joint Training Center, hereinafter referred to as the "Post" and the Camp Blanding Rod and Gun Club, Inc., 5629 State Road 16 West, Camp Blanding Joint Training Center, Starke, Florida 32091-9703, hereinafter referred to as the "Club".
2. Club agrees to:
 - a. Abide by all Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission regulations, federal and state laws governing the taking of wild game and fish, and all of the Post policies and regulations.
 - b. Protect and preserve all federal and state property located on the Post.
 - c. Receive explicit written consent from the Post, prior to creating any new roadway.
 - d. Pay to the Director of Resource Management reimbursement for any metered monthly electrical usage.
 - e. Responsible for all maintenance and repair to kiosk located at Treat Road Gate #A-34 and Building #1530.
 - f. Accept full responsibility for the actions and safety of its members and guests and ensure that this agreement is adhered to at all times.
 - g. Ensure that the cables located at Blue Pond Road/New Impact Road and Old Impact Road/New Impact Road are not violated at any time. The Camp Blanding Trespassing Policy will be enforced against any individual(s) violating these cables.
 - h. Responsible for ensuring that its members police up all trash within their hunting area.
 - i. Responsible for posting property boundary signs at 50-meter intervals on all hunting and fishing areas. **NOTE: The signs should not read, "no trespassing"; they should mark the boundary only.**
 - j. Ensure that there is absolutely **NO** hunting on Treat Road when Area "C" is closed for Range Firing on ARF, ARF #2 and the Zero Ranges.

3. Outline of Hunting Areas and boundaries as shown on the enclosed map.
- a. Area "A": **This area has been changed from previous years.** Start at Duval Rd. and Avenue D, go South along Duval to the railroad crossing. Follow the railroad tracks Northward to Avon Park St., then North to Avenue D, West to Duval Rd.
 - b. Area "B": Beginning at the Club gate on Treat Rd, continue South to the airport fence line, West to the Post boundary, North to the railroad track, East along the railroad track to the barbed wire boundary on the western edge of the Dupont sand pile, Southeast to Treat Road, South to the Club gate.
 - c. Area "C": The boundary will start at the center of Levy, East of Treat Road gate and continue South approximately one mile. Levy will turn East for one half of a mile. Upon reaching the North side of the ARF #1 Zero Range, the boundary will run East for approximately one-tenth of a mile; there a barbwire fence will run to the South, curving to the East, this is the Eastern boundary of Area "C". When this fence line runs into Blue Pond, the boundary follows the Southern shoreline of Blue Pond to a barbwire fence which runs to the Southeast from the East side of Blue Pond to Perch Pond Road. The boundary is this fence line as it turns and follows the East side of perch Pond Road to the South until it reaches Impact Road. The boundary then runs West along the North side of Impact Road to Treat Road, North along the East side of Treat Road to the Treat Road gate. **NOTE: The ARF Ranges located within the stated boundaries, are OFF LIMITS. Members are authorized to use Old Impact, Fender Levy and Blue Pond roads for game retrieval only. Perch Pond Road will be used for parking for the Eastern part of Area "C".**
 - d. Area "D": Start at Avenue D and Whitmore Lake Rd., go South about 350 yards to an unnamed road along the tree line. Go Northeast along the tree line until it bends to the South. Go South to a dirt trail that will lead to Jones Rd. Turn North and follow Jones Rd. to Dade Rd., go North along Dade Rd. to Avenue D, go Westward to Whitmore Lake Rd.
 - e. Area "DD": Start at the intersection of Avenue D and Live Oak St. Follow Avenue D Northeast to an unnamed lime rock trail across from the FFWCC compound, go South along this trail to Polk Rd. Take Polk Rd to Live Oak St. Take Live Oak St. back to Avenue D. This area is for Shotgun and Archery.
 - f. Area "F": Start at Camp Blanding fence that parallels SR 16, East of Avenue D, Southward to the North Creek Fork, West to Avenue C, North to Camp Blanding fence at SR 16. There will be no hunting allowed in the area South of the creek fork.
 - g. Area "G": Start at Camp Blanding fence that parallels SR 16, go East to Avenue C, South to Jacksonville Street, West to Avenue B, Northwest to Pump House Road. Follow Pump House Road North to Sawmill Rd. Follow Sawmill Rd. East to the road that borders RTSM on the East.

- h. Area "H": Start at St. Petersburg St. Go East to Avenue B, South to Ft. Lauderdale St., West to Avenue A.
- i. Area "I": Start at Hollywood St. Go East to Avenue B. Go South to Lake City St then West to Avenue A.
- j. Area "J": Start at the intersection of Avenue B and Jacksonville St. Follow Avenue B North past Fort Myers St. to the end of the tree line. Go West following the tree line to the back of the Consolidated Dining Facility. Turn Southeast towards Fort Myers St. Go Northeast on Fort Myers St. approximately 210 yards to the first road past the southern tree line. Turn Southeast and follow the road to Jacksonville St. Follow Jacksonville St. back to Avenue B.
- k. Area "R": Start at Orlando Street. Go East to Fish & Game Biologist Compound. Go South to Crestview Street then West to Avenue C.
- l. Area "S": Start at Crestview. Go East to Avenue D then South to Palmetto Street. Go West to Avenue C.
- m. Area "T": Start at Avenue B and Hollywood St. Follow Avenue B Southwest 416 yards. Turn Southeast and follow tree line 150 yards to an intersection of two unnamed roads; continue going Southeast to next intersection. Turn Northeast and go 2 blocks. Turn northwest and go one block. Turn Northeast and go one block to Hollywood St. Turn North and go to Avenue B. This area is for Archery only.
- n. Area "U": Start at Defuniak Springs Rd. and Avenue C. Go East to Quincy Avenue. Go South to Live Oak St. Go East to Avenue D. South to Marianna St. West to Plant City Avenue. South to N. Miami St. East to Avenue D. South to Miami St. Northwest to Avenue C, then back to Defuniak Springs Rd.
- o. Area "W": Start at the intersection of Duval Rd. and Avenue A. Follow Avenue A West ending at Lake City St. Take Lake City St. South ending at Avenue B. Take Avenue B West ending at Duval Rd. Follow Duval Rd. North ending at Avenue A. This area is for Archery only. **NOTE: The area contains a land navigation course, therefore this area might be closed periodically for military use.**
- p. Area "X": Start at the intersection of Old SR 225 and Woodbury Rd. Travel North along Camp Blanding fence approximately 0.3 miles Northwest then North on Woods Road approximately 0.7 miles. Go West to Old SR 225 then go Southeast to the intersection of Old SR 225 and Woodbury Rd. **NOTE: Area "X" is subject to closure based on the mining operations priority.**

4. Parking:

- a. Vehicles will be parked on the side of the road so that they do not interfere with the normal flow of traffic. Vehicles cannot block fire hydrants, entrances to support facilities, compounds, gates or intersections.
 - b. No vehicles will be allowed in the walk-in areas except for placing/extracting tree stands and the recovery of downed game.
 - c. No parking will be allowed from the Blue Pond boat ramp to Old Impact Road or on New Impact Road.
 - d. It is mandatory for all hunters hunting in Area "B" park on the west side of Treat Road and on the east side of Treat Road for Area "C".
 - e. Parking for Areas A, B and C will be designated as shown on the attached map. Parking for Area "C" is authorized along the side of Treat Road up to Old Impact Road.
 - f. Parking for Area "X" will be on the east side of State Road 225 (Parking will be in such a manner as not to interfere with Dupont operations.).
 - g. Parking is authorized on Old Impact Road. Parking is also authorized on Blue Pond Road up to the eastern boundary.
5. Entrance Areas:
- a. Entrance to designated hunting areas will be by Avenues A, B, C or D. Area "X" will be entered from State Road 225.
 - b. Areas "B" and "C" will be entered and exited through the Club's Treat Road gate only. **NOTE: The Main Gate is the only gate to be used for access to all other hunting areas with the exception of Area "X".**
6. Authorized weapons for each hunting area are as follows:
- a. Hunting with dogs in Area "B" must be coordinated with Range Control on Post.
 - b. Muzzleloaders and shotguns are authorized in Areas A, B, C, D, DD, F, G and X.
 - c. Cross bows are authorized in Areas A, B, C, D, F and X (during modern gun season only).
 - d. Areas H, I, J, R, S, T, U and W are designated as archery areas only. (Area "G" is authorized use of muzzleloaders and shotguns inside designated, marked area only.).
 - e. Areas B, C and X are the only areas where rifles are authorized. (Area "B" is authorized use of rifles only when the ARF Ranges are COLD.). **NOTE: SHOTGUNS ARE THE ONLY WEAPONS THAT ARE AUTHORIZED FOR HUNTING ON TREAT ROAD.**

f. Long bows and compound bows are authorized in all areas.

7. Approved Fishing Areas: **NOTE: Wade-Fishing is prohibited in these ponds.**

a. Blue Pond – Entrance will be off of Treat Road, south of the Zero Range, on Blue Pond Road and is approximately ½ mile east on Blue Pond Road.

b. Perch Pond – Entrance will be off of Treat Road onto New Impact Road for approximately 2 miles, then left onto Perch Pond Road for approximately 300 meters.

c. OP Pond – Located at the intersection of Yerkes and Treat Roads on the south side. Entrance will be made at the entrance to OP Pond. Parking will be at the pond.

d. Capps Pond – Located 200 meters north of the Treat Road gate on the east side of the road. This pond does not have a boat ramp, so entrance and parking will be on the east side of the road. Fishing this pond will require the use of a small boat.

e. Long Pond – Located approximately halfway between Treat Road gate and the Zero Range, on the east side of the road. Entrance will be made by going through the gate and proceeding 100 meters on the dirt road. Parking will be made by the levy that surrounds the pond on the west side. This pond does not have a boat ramp, so fishing will require a small boat carried over the levy.

f. Golden Pond – Entrance will be made by the Treat Road gate to the east and follow the barbwire fence to the launch site.

8. The R&G Club hunting may be temporarily suspended based on CBJTC Force Protection requirements.

9. Hunting areas A through X and all six fishing ponds will be included in the weekly memorandum “Instructions for Training Week”, published by the CB-PTD. **NOTE:** None of these areas contained in the agreement will be entered into for any reason when they are published as being closed. **(This bulletin will be posted at the club’s designated kiosk locations.)**


10. The Club accepts full responsibility for the actions and safety of its members and guests. They will ensure that hunting, fishing, and plot preparation only occur during those times as published in item #9 above, and during prescribed seasons as published by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FFWCC) (Access to food plots must be coordinated with the CBJTC Plans and Training Division). All Club member and guests will adhere to all laws, rules and regulations of the FFWCC. Violators of this policy will be subject to privilege revocation by the Post Commander. The Club will also ensure that its members and guests adhere to the boundaries of each area and are given a safety briefing to include no handling of dud ammunition and no violations of roadblocks without permission from the Post. The Club will further ensure that the contents of this agreement are adhered to at all times.

11. The Club agrees that without recourse, in the event of a national emergency requiring the use of Camp Blanding for military purposes, that this agreement will immediately terminate and that the Club will evacuate the premises. Said evacuation to be accomplished within 30 days of receiving written notice from the Armory Board, State of Florida.

12. This Agreement is for a 12-month period commencing on 1 June 2009, ending on 30 May 2010, and may be reviewed at any time that a change in ranges, training areas or construction affects the areas contained herein and is also subject to cancellation by either party with a 30-day written notice.
